(Washington, DC) – Ward 4 Councilmember Muriel Bowser is very pleased to welcome the Kennedy Street Clean and Safe Team on Monday, August 11, 2008 at 10:30 am in front of Yum’s Carry Out at 628 Kennedy Street, NW (corner of 7th and Kennedy Streets, NW). “I am thrilled that the Kennedy Street Clean and Safe Team will begin work this week,” said Councilmember Bowser. “The team will provide an important service to the Kennedy Street commercial corridor which will increase cleanliness and improve public safety. This project is continuing my commitment to focus on key Ward 4 commercial corridors and ensure that they are thriving with businesses and residents wanting to use the services offered,” she added.

The Kennedy Street Clean and Safe Team will launch service delivery on Monday, August 11, 2008. The Kennedy Street Clean and Safe Team will provide litter and graffiti removal from the curbs and sidewalks, tree box maintenance, debris transfer, and other public space maintenance services Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. on the Kennedy Street corridor from Georgia Avenue, NW to North Capitol Street, NW. A crew will also provide services on Saturdays and Sundays from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm.

This project is funded by the DC Department of Public Works (DPW) and managed by the Columbia Heights/Shaw Family Support Collaborative, which has been awarded a grant through the DC Department of Small and Local Business Development.

Neighborhood businesses and residents are welcome to come hear about this great new project that will help revitalize this important commercial corridor.
