

Subject: Circulation of Congressional Review Emergency Legislation

This memorandum serves as my notice to move the following pieces of legislation at the January 4, 2012, Legislative Meeting:

- Criminal Penalty For Unregistered Motorist Repeal Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2012.
- Criminal Penalty For Unregistered Motorist Repeal Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2012.

The Criminal Penalty For Unregistered Motorist Repeal Emergency Amendment Act of 2011 (A19-208) expires on January 19, 2012. The Criminal Penalty For Unregistered Motorist Repeal Temporary Amendment Act of 2012, signed by the Mayor on November 21, 2011 (A19-236) has an expected law date of January 26, 2012. The congressional review emergency is necessary to ensure that the provisions of the emergency continue without interruption until the temporary is in effect.
